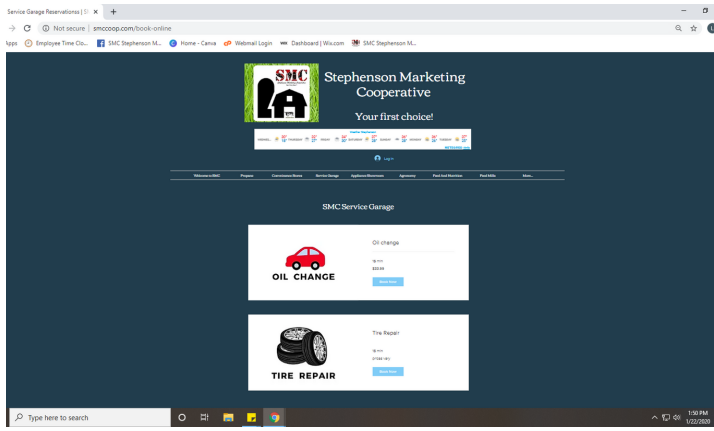
2 LEE'S FARM
