SERVINGS: 48 BARS PREP TIME: 40 MIN

COOK/ BAKE TIME: 12-18 MIN.

INGREDIENTS:

BASE-

1 PKG. PILLSBURY MOIST SUPREME YELLOW CAKE MIX 1/3 CUP MARGARINE OR BUTTER , SOFTENED

1 EGG

3 CUPS OF MINIATURE MARSHMALLOWS

TOPPING-

2/3 CUP CORN SYRUP

1/4 CUP MARARINE OF BUTTER

2 TEASPPONS VANILLA

1 PKG PEANUT BUTTER CHIPS

2 CUPS CRISP RICE CEREAL

2 CUPS SALTED PEANUTS

SALTED PEANUT CHEWS

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. HEAT OVEN TO 350*F. IN A LARGE BOWL, COMBINE CAKE MIX, 1/3 CUP BUTTER AND EGG; BEAT AT LOW SPEED UNTIL CRUMBLY. PRESS IN BOTTOM OF UNGREASED 13X9 INCH PAN.
- 2. BAKE AT 350*F FOR 12 TO 18 MINUTES OR UNTIL LIGHT GOLDEN BROWN. REMOVE FROM OVEN AND IMMEDIATELY SPRINKLE WITH MARSHMALLOWS. RETURN TO OVEN; BAKE AND ADDITIONAL 1 TO 2 MINUTES OR UNTIL MARSHMALLOWS JUST BEGIN TO PUFF. COOL WHILE PREPARING TOPPING.
- 3. IN LARGE SAUCE PAN, COMBINE ALL TOPPING INGREDIENTS EXCEPT CEREAL AND PEANUTS.
 HEAT JUST UNTIL CHIPS ARE MELTED AND MIXTURE IS SMOOTH, STIRRING CONSTANTLY.
 REMOVE FROM HEAT; STIR IN CEREAL AND PEANUTS. IMMEDIATELY SPOON WARM TOPPING
 OVER MARSHMALLOWS; SPREAD TO COVER. REFRIGERATE 1 HOUR OR UNTIL FIRM. CUT
 INTO BARS. STORE IN COVERED CONTAINERS.
